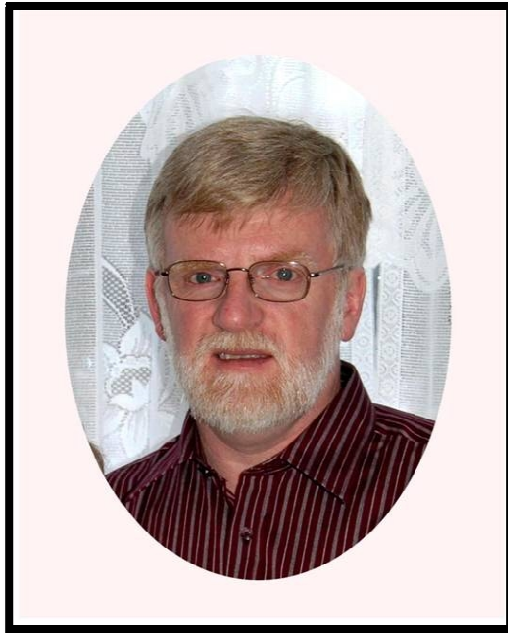




Mount Pearl Sports Hall of Fame Inductee

Only kind words can be spoken of Dan Maher; one of the most devoted and thoughtful of Mount Pearl's sport builders. Dan's involvement has been so extensive that it would be impossible to list all his accomplishments, thus, here is a mere glimpse at the time and effort Dan has bestowed upon our athletes.

Dan officiated in all Provincial Soccer Tournaments held in the Metro area circa 1992-2008 and was referee in most of those tournaments including being in the middle of two games during the 2002 National Challenge Cup Tournament. He is actively involved in the Provincial Referees Association, he has been actively involved in the soccer community as a player, coach, referee, volunteer, convener, Executive Member, Referee Instructor, and photographer since 1976, and he is a past recipient of the Ross Arlett Memorial Award. Dan extended his knowledge in

soccer to train Special Olympic athletes who later placed within the top three placements provincially and nationally. Moreover, by voluntarily photographing sporting events for the past 27 years, Dan has singlehandedly granted the history of sport in Mount Pearl its preservation.
