Mary Holloway's volunteerism demonstrates, with outstanding integrity, what love for others and the love for sport can accomplish. Her leadership, management and organizational skills have allowed Special Olympians to demonstrate their outstanding athleticism.

Mary was instrumental in introducing the Special Olympic athletes as participants in the Generic NL Summer Games, she serves as liaison and representative for the Special Olympics with a variety of institutions both provincially and nationally, and has helped create, coordinate, and convene numerous training camps, Special Olympic events such as the LETR Touch Run, and a variety of Special Olympics programs (such as the Youth Athletes Program) and competitions. She has been named both provincial and national Special Olympic Volunteer of the Year in 2005 and in 2008 was the recipient of the Bridging the Gap Awards. Mary was

also one of only 25 recipients in Canada to be awarded the Investors Group Coach Developer Award. These tremendous accomplishments are a mere glimpse of the contributions Mary has bestowed upon the athletes of Mount Pearl.
